Important Parts of Persuasive Writing

- 1. **Introduction**: open by explaining what the issue is and what you think about the issue. Be specific about what you want.
- 2. **Evidence**: time to persuade the reader with reasons. Use your ideas, a core democratic value, or data. Explain how your evidence matches.
- 3. Evidence: explain another reason your reader should believe you.
- 4. Evidence: at least one more reason to prove your case. Explain it.
- 5. **Conclusion**: restate your idea so the reader is clear. End with a fresh way to make the reader think about your ideas.
